

VCR/DVD Equipment Use Policy

Due to legal restrictions of the U. S. Copyright Act, library- owned VCR and DVD equipment is NOT available for use by the public.

Exceptions can be made by the Library Director or his/her designee on a case by case basis in the following circumstances:

1. If the organization using the equipment and the purpose for which the equipment is used clearly meet guidelines for classroom use as established by the U. S. Copyright Act.
2. If the videos to be used are public performance videos. Patrons using library-owned VCR/DVD and television equipment for public performances must sign a contract specifying that they will only use videos which are designated for "public performance".

VCR and DVD equipment may only be used within the library. The library does not loan VCR or DVD equipment for use in other locations.

VCR and DVD equipment may only be used by adult patrons (patrons who are 18 years of age or over).
