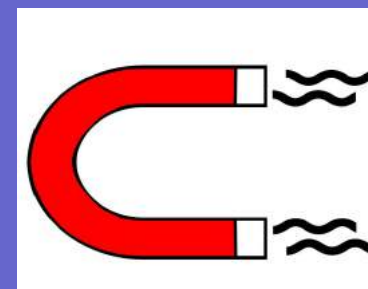

The East Regional Library will host "Joyful Noise" Wednesday, February 28 at 6:45 pm.

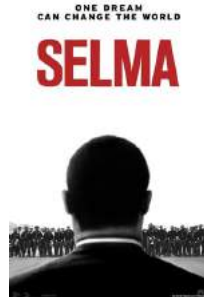


This musical celebration will feature the choir and musicians of the Rising Star Baptist Church of LaPlace.
