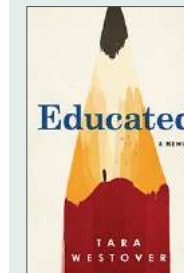

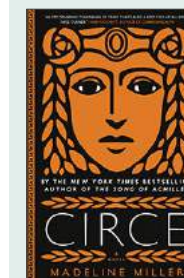

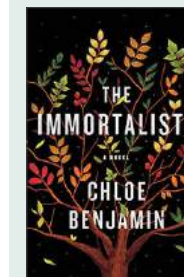

Our online eBook services, hoopla and OverDrive, can help you find a cookbook anytime, anywhere.

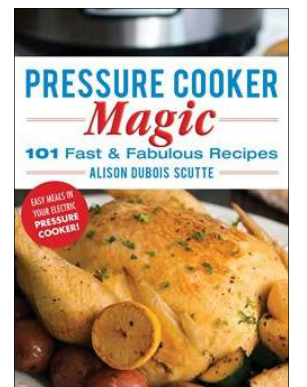
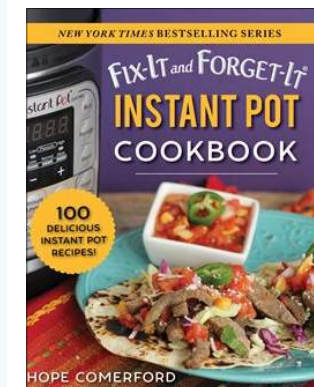
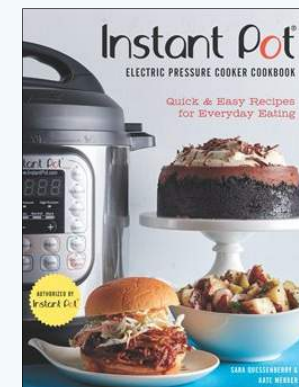
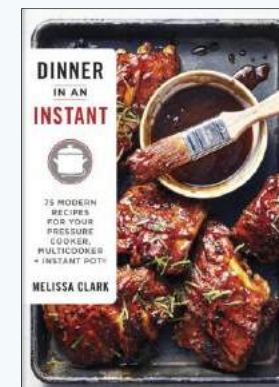

## WIRELESS PRINTING WITH PRINTERON

Using our wireless printing service, PrinterOn, you can send documents, photos, and more to library printers from your personal computer or mobile device from inside or outside the library.

You can send your documents to be printed from the "Print, Copy, Scan" page of our website or by using the PrinterOn app, available for Apple and Android devices.

Once you send your document to print, visit the circulation desk and let us know that you need to pick up what you sent to the printer. We'll verify your information and you'll be on your way.

The service is available during the library's open hours. Black and white copies are 10¢ and color copies are 25¢.
