Not a #Number, a three-night interactive child trafficking prevention workshop for ages 12-14, takes place Monday, June 25 through Wednesday, June 27 from 6 p.m. to 7:30 pm at the East Regional Library, 160 W. Campus Dr. in Destrehan.
