We're celebrating early at the East Regional Library on October 19 from 5:30pm to 8:30pm.

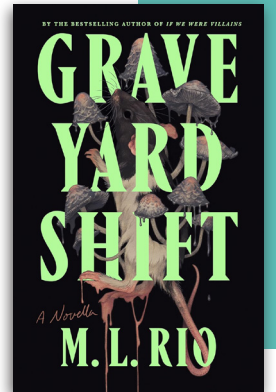
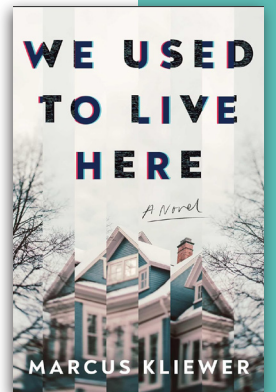
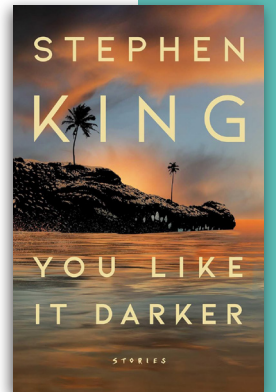
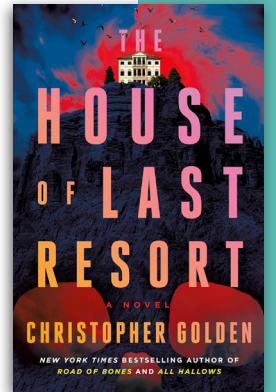
