- Tissue Paper (Assorted Colors)
- Craft tube
- Large pom poms
- Small pom poms
- Googly eyes
- Decorative paper
- Sheet of glue dots

- Stapler
- Scissors

### Instructions

1. Wrap the decorative paper around the craft tube and secure with glue/tape. (Fold excess paper into the tube)
2. Use glue dots to secure the eyes (large pom poms) and nostrils (small pom poms)
3. Use the glue dots to secure the googly eyes on the large pom poms (press firmly).
4. Use glue/glue dots to place the tissue paper strips in the tube.
5. Now you can breathe fire like a dragon!

### Instructions

1. Roll poster board into a cone shape and secure with tape.
2. Cut the larger opening so that it becomes a flat circle with no pointed edges.
3. Use template to cut out the spikes/triangles from the cardstock.
4. Glue spikes to the cone by folding just the bottom of each spike.
5. Cut ribbon in half and staple one to the inside of the larger side of the cone. Do the same with the other side with the remaining ribbon.
6. Decorate your Dragon tail with the dots.
7. Finally tie your tail to your waist and use your blower to “breathe fire.”
8. Guess what??!! YOUR A DRAGON!!!!
